## Ollie’s Legacy

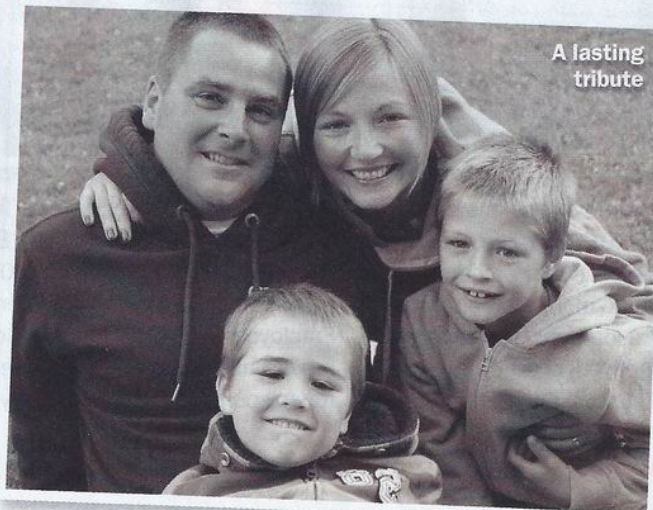
**O**llie’s death was caused by a grade IV glioblastoma multiforme brain tumour. High-grade tumours of this type are

rare in children but increasing in incidence. The causes are not currently known.

“We have set up the Ollie Young Foundation to raise vital funds for

research into brain tumours in children,” says Simon Young, Ollie’s dad. “Additional funds will be directed to CLIC Sargent and Helen & Douglas House in recognition of the wonderful care my family received during and after Ollie’s illness.
