AN AUDIO system for the hall at Hawthorns Primary School will be installed this month, thanks to a successful fundraising fair.

The PTA at the Woosehill school raised £4,000 at the fete, bringing its annual fundraising total to £16,000.

PTA chairman Steve Gray said: "The turnout was excellent compared to last year when the weather was bad. This year we had about 500 people."
